## 2016 Has Been 'Year of the Challenge!'

In a move that confirmed the depth of the Board's support for — and commitment to — the Foundation, it pledged to match donations to the Foundation, dollar-for-dollar, up to \$25,000.

The impact of this Challenge is pretty heady stuff for your AMCP Foundation! It handed us the exciting prospect of turning \$25,000 into \$50,000 for support of the Foundation's educational and research mission. How are we doing so far in this race to \$50 grand? Through Dec. 14, the Foundation has raised \$19,789.70 from individual member donations and raffle ticket sales received since Oct. 1. Add in the AMCP Board's Challenge Grant money and the Foundation's

total will be at \$39,574.40.

The AMCP Foundation recently released two major reports that address some of the most perplexing challenges facing the U.S. health care
