



#### The US Senate

- ➤ Republicans (52 Seats)
- ➤ Democrats (46 Seats)
- ➤ Independents (2)
- ➤ Senate Passed a Budget Resolution Aimed at Defunding Major Provisions of the ACA Through the Budget Reconciliation Process

#### **Potential Scenarios**

- >ACA Repeal, but No Replacement
- ➤ Kill ACA through Budget Reconciliation Process
  ➤ Pass Replacement Later

# **Potential Scenarios**

- Repeal ACA, and Replace with:
  - >Actual Replacement Bill Language
    - ➤ (Most Likely Scenario)
  - ➤ Directions to Call a "Joint Committee on Health Reform" with a Deadline to Produce Bill Language

#### Considerations

- ➤ Earliest the Replacement Bill Enacted is 2019, but more Likely 2020-2022
- ➤ Repealing the ACA has been a Republican Priority since 2008
- Producing Bill Language Takes Time
- Looming 2018 Midterm Elections
  - > Senate Republicans Hold a Slim Majority (52 seats)
