RE: H.R. 4841 – Standardizing Electronic Prior Authorization for Safe Prescribing Act of 2018

## Dear Representative Schweikert:

The Academy of Managed Care Pharmacy (AMCP) commends you on your leadership as the sponsor of H.R. 4841 and Representatives Ben Ray Lujan, Bill Johnson and Mike Thompson for joining with you. AMCP strongly supports electronic prior authorization (ePA). The prior authorization process is designed to ensure that the medications patients receive are safe, effective and provide the greatest value. As you know, the ePA process provides real-time responses which increase the efficiency and responsiveness of all parties involved in the process.

AMCP is the nation's leading professional association dedicated to increasing patient access to affordable medicines, improving health outcomes and ensuring the wise use of health care dollars. Through evidence- and value-based strategies and practices, the Academy's 8,000 pharmacists, physicians, nurses and other practitioners manage medication therapies for the 270 million Americans served by health plans, pharmacy benefit management firms, emerging care models and government.

The commercial marketplace has already seen the benefits of ePA and using the NCPDP SCRIPT ePA standard. Many of the providers in the Medicare network are already using ePA and the transition will be seamless. We applaud your efforts to bring that same level of increased efficiency to the Medicare program and its beneficiaries.
