

Managed Care 101 Speaker Series for Pacific

University: August 30th Board members Armen Khachatourian, Leslie Mann, and Randy Gustafson, were invited to provide the School of Pharmacy students an introduction to managed care and all the career opportunities that it encompasses.

Managed Care Day (Oregon)

- ✓ Held in late November, 15 students from University of Washington, Pacific University and Oregon State spent a full day touring, exploring and learning managed care first hand with the help of local health plans. Thomas Lee, AMCP-NW Colleges of Pharmacy Liaison, coordinated tours and presentations for the students at Regence BCBS, Moda Health and Pacific Source. The students learned about different career opportunities, the current challenges in managed care, and how to be a competitive residency applicant. The students had the chance to ask questions during several Q&A sessions with managed care pharmacists, pharmacy residents, and residency program directors. They also had the opportunity to do on-site tours at three health plans to get a feel for the day-to-day life of a pharmacist.
- ✓ New this year – Students finished the day with an Industry Roundtable, engaging with Pharmacists working in a variety of roles within Industry, including: Mary Kemhus, Novartis; Dan Allen, Sanofi; and Bridget Hernandez, Boehringer Ingelheim.

Student Travel Grants: 2019 AMCP Annual Meeting in San Diego

- Travel grants applications were open to current PharmD students who are attending pharmacy schools within the AMCP-NW Region and who are current members of AMCP. The applicant had to complete a brief essay on what they will gain from attending the AMCP Annual Meeting and how that experience will contribute to their professional goals.
- We received seven applications from four different pharmacy schools. The AMCP-NW Board is proud to offer travel grants to each of the following individuals:
 - **Kaitlyn Molina (Oregon State University/Oregon Health & Science University)** - Kaitlyn is very involved in AMCP at the student level and is currently the President-Elect of the student chapter at OSU/OHSU. One of her goals in her leadership position is to improve students' participation in the P&T competition. Through this competition, students gain hands-on experience with the fundamentals of formulary management and explore their interest in managed care. One way she hopes to encourage teams to compete is by organizing a speaker series for participating students which will give them the skills necessary to be successful in the competition. By attending the 2019 AMCP Annual Conference, she hopes to talk to successful teams and gain insight on the types of speakers she should invite to best prepare her classmates. She has also enrolled in the Chapter Leadership Academy where student chapter leaders are given tools and best-practices to improve the student chapter experience.
 - **Ryan Scherrer (Washington State University)** - Ryan is one of the founding members of the newly created student chapter at WSU. One of the biggest challenges that the new AMCP chapter faces is understanding what resources they need to attract new student members and to encourage engagement, growth, and professional development. By attending the 2019 AMCP National Conference, Ryan will be able to connect with students from more established chapters and learn best-practices that he can bring back to WSU. Ryan also has a personal interest in research which initially led him to be curious about managed care pharmacy. He expressed a desire to understand the kinds of projects that managed care pharmacists are involved in and how they are addressing the current challenges facing the healthcare system. By attending the conference, this will give him the opportunity to meet practicing pharmacists and understand the innovative solutions that are being implemented to improve care for patient populations.
