MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

ACTIVE MEMBER – \$275

Pharmacists, Physicians, Nurses, and Physician Assistants who are individuals who are licensed or eligible for licensure to practice the profession of pharmacy in the United States and its possessions supporting the mission and objectives of AMCP. Active members hold full voting rights and have the privilege to serve on all AMCP committees and run for the Board of Directors. If you have graduated in the last two years, your dues will be 50% of the Active member dues! AMCP is also proud to offer 50% off Active dues to those who are active duty in the uniformed services. Your dues rate will be automatically adjusted when you join. If you are over 65 and have retired full time from the profession, please contact member services.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER – \$440

Associate members are other individuals, not eligible for Active memberships, who are interested in the advancement and development of managed care pharmacy practices, regardless of practice environment and support the mission and objectives of AMCP. Associate members serve on a number of AMCP committees. AMCP is proud to offer 50% off Associate dues to those who are active duty in the uniformed services. Your dues rate will be automatically adjusted when you join. If you are over 65 and have retired full time from the profession, please contact member services.

RESIDENT/FELLOW/GRADUATE STUDENT MEMBER – \$100

Resident/Fellow/Graduate Student members must be enrolled full-time in a graduate/postgraduate school program recognized by the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE) or practicing full-time in a residency or fellowship related to pharmacy or managed care pharmacy. Resident/Fellow/Graduate Student members can lend their expertise in a variety of ways including AMCP committee service and virtual focus groups.

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN MEMBER – \$145

AMCP's newest membership category! Individuals who are a certified pharmacy technician and/or practicing in a pharmacy technician role are eligible for this category. Pharmacy Technicians do not have voting rights but may serve on a number of AMCP committees.


