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Capstone Project

- Clinical and Financial Impact of Downsizing Refill Care Coordination in Specialty Pharmacy
 - A retrospective cohort study designed to determine if reducing refill reminder outreaches for patients in the autoimmune class significantly impacts adherence rates while minimizing operational costs
 - Findings to be presented at AMCP 2020
 - Joint effort between medical chiefs of staff, specialty pharmacy and management



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Other Primary Projects

Biosimilar Conversion

- Developed a strategy to educate and convert
- Designed and implemented educational materials for both patients and front line staff

Medicare Part D

- Created a presentation on Medicare Part D and its structure within KP's integrated system
- Determined impact for cost savings for Medicare plan patients

Xeljanz Formulary Status

- Validated submitted report from Pfizer to suggest large savings if Xeljanz was moved to unrestricted on formulary

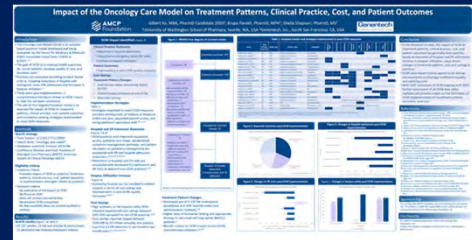

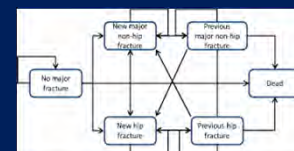
- Targeted literature review: “Impact of the Oncology Care Model on treatment patterns, cost, patient, and clinical practice outcomes”
