RE: Student Travel Award for the 2020 AMCP Annual Meeting

The NW-AMCP Affiliate of the Academy of Managed Care Pharmacy (AMCP) is offering two \$500 travel awards to help defray registration, travel and lodging expenses for AMCP student members to attend the 2020 AMCP Annual meeting being held in Houston, TX at the George R. Brown Convention Center, April 21<sup>st</sup> to April 24<sup>th</sup>. The organization values student members and their contribution to the profession, and also recognizes the networking and educational benefits they gain from attending an AMCP national meeting.

To qualify for the travel award, you must be a **PharmD student** at one of the accredited Colleges of Pharmacy within the NW-AMCP Affiliate region and a **current member of AMCP**. Your application must include a brief essay on what you will gain from attending the 2020 AMCP Annual meeting and how it will contribute to your professional goals related to pharmacy. If you are given a travel award, you will be asked to present a brief (10 minute) summary of your meeting experience at a future NW-AMCP Affiliate event.

Members of the NW-AMCP Affiliate Board will conduct the applicant review. The evaluation will be based on the submitted essay, with judges also considering whether the applicant is giving a poster or podium presentation at the meeting. The Board will select two students from accredited Colleges of Pharmacy within the NW-AMCP Affiliate region (WA, OR, ID, MT, AK and HI) to receive the travel awards.
