ICER and other Value Frameworks Available on FormularyDecisions



Based on current syndicated metrics and feedback for 2019, the FormularyDecisions (FD) payer community is using value frameworks for formulary reviews. Active payers indicated ICER, NCCN, and ASCO value frameworks were useful (4 of 5 usefulness rating for each). ICER was the most widely used (73%, n=1482) and two-thirds of those evaluating products associated with an ICER report had either used or were intending to use the report as part of their review.
