

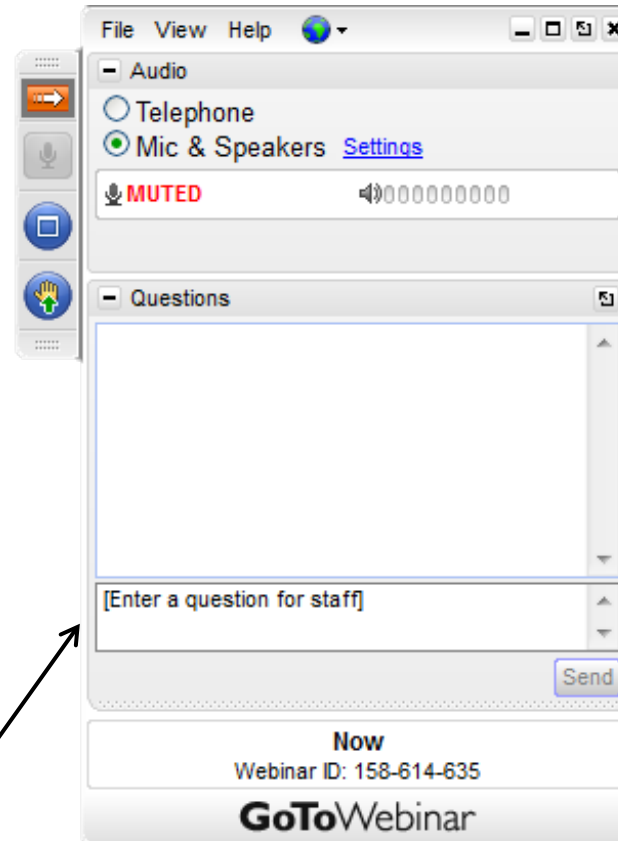

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Managed Care Residency Accreditation Status

- ASHP in partnership with AMCP
- All programs must meet requirements in these areas:
 - Residency design
 - Policies
 - Curriculum
 - Resident feedback and evaluation
 - Resident development through residency

Managed Care Residency Accreditation

- Pre-candidate status- applied for accreditation, but no resident in program yet
- Candidate status- has resident in program, not yet accredited
- Accredited- has received accreditation from ASHP in partnership with AMCP

Managed Care Residency Accreditation Implications

- If resident is in candidate status program which becomes accredited, the accreditation is retroactive to the residents in the candidate status program.
- Graduates from accredited programs can sit for BCPS board certification exams immediately.
- Some employers require/prefer graduates from accredited residency programs.
- External accreditation helps ensure resident's best interest is kept in mind.

Managed Care Residency Accreditation Stats

- Accredited PGY1 Managed Care residency programs – 50
- Accredited PGY1 Managed Care residency positions- 85

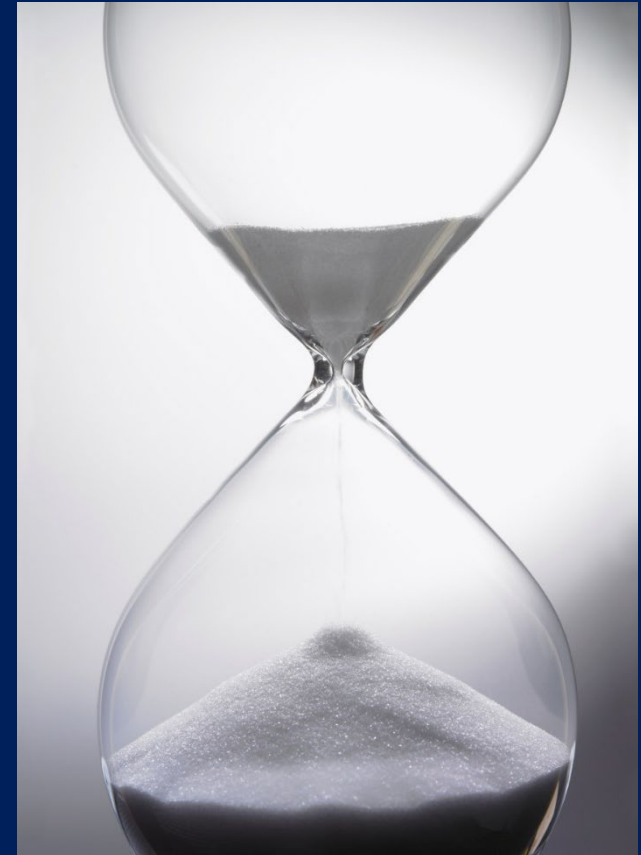

PGY1 Managed Care Residency Characteristics

Highly Variable

- Setting
- Lines of Business
- # of Residents
- Patient Care Experiences
- # of Preceptors
- Teaching Components
- Staffing Expectations
- # of Pharmacists

Mostly Consistent

- Mix of Rotational and Longitudinal Learning Experiences
 - Orientation
 - Formulary Management
 - Drug Information
 - Prior Authorization
 - Clinical Programs
 - Analytics, etc.
- Presentations
- Evaluations
 - PharmAcademic™



Common Areas for Improvement

- Diverse work and school experiences
 - Including managed care and other areas of interest
- Volunteer experiences
- Active involvement in pharmacy organizations
- Self-awareness and reflection
- Research experiences
- Presentation experiences



Tips and Advice

- Let current preceptors know you're interested in managed care
- Research programs of interest and reach out to the current resident(s) there

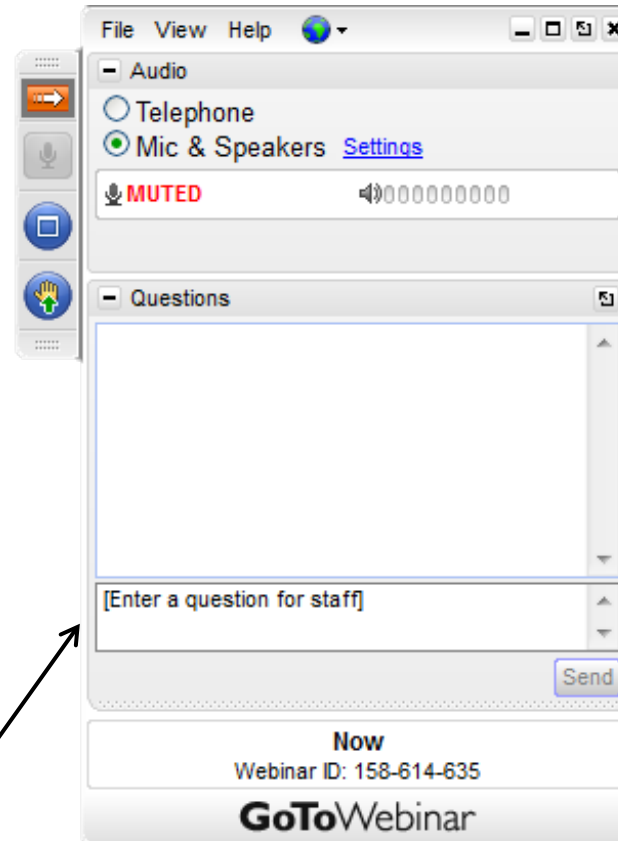
