## **Legislative Committee:**

Update on HB 389 - Collaborative Practice and Test and Treat

In an attempt to make health care more affordable and available, Speaker of the House Jose Oliva persuaded lawmakers to pass the law (HB 389) allowing pharmacists to enter into collaborative arrangements with physicians to treat patients for chronic medical conditions that include arthritis; asthma; chronic obstructive pulmonary diseases; Type 2 diabetes; human immunodeficiency virus or acquired immune deficiency syndrome; and obesity. This was signed into effect by Governor Desantis at the end of session and given to the Board of Pharmacy for rulemaking in July. Members of the Rules Committee gave tentative approval to a proposed rule that added opioid abuse disorder; hypertension; hyperlipidemia; smoking cessation; and anticoagulation management to the conditions that were identified in the law. Also being heavily debated is the addition of heart failure and/or cardiovascular disease; as well as mental health. The last board meeting was held on mid October. Stay tuned for future board meetings. As always, these are open to the public.
