Supreme Court Hears Oral Arguments in *California v. Texas*

On Nov. 10, the Supreme Court heard oral arguments in *California v. Texas*, a case challenging the constitutionality of the individual mandate in the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (ACA). A ruling declaring the entire law unconstitutional could negate pharmacy benefits and would remove protections for the 135 million Americans who have pre-existing conditions.
