NewsBREAK | Nov. 21
CMS Issues Final Rule on Changes to the Physician Fee Schedule and Other Medicare Changes

This final rule addresses a variety of topics, including but not limited to:

- Changes to the physician fee schedule (PFS);
- Extending certain Medicare telehealth flexibilities;
- Requiring manufacturers of certain single-dose container or single-use package drugs payable under Medicare Part B to provide refunds for discarded amounts;
- Requiring electronic prescribing for controlled substances for a covered Part D drug under a Prescription Drug Plan or an MA-PD Plan;
- Medicare coverage of opioid use disorder services furnished by opioid treatment programs;
- Medicare Part B payment for preventive vaccine administration services;
- Updating conditions of payment for DMEPOS suppliers;
- Finalizing the CY 2022 Methadone Payment Exception for Opioid Treatment Programs interim final rule; and
- Finalizing certain provisions included in the COVID-19 interim final rule.

These regulations are effective on Jan. 1, 2023.

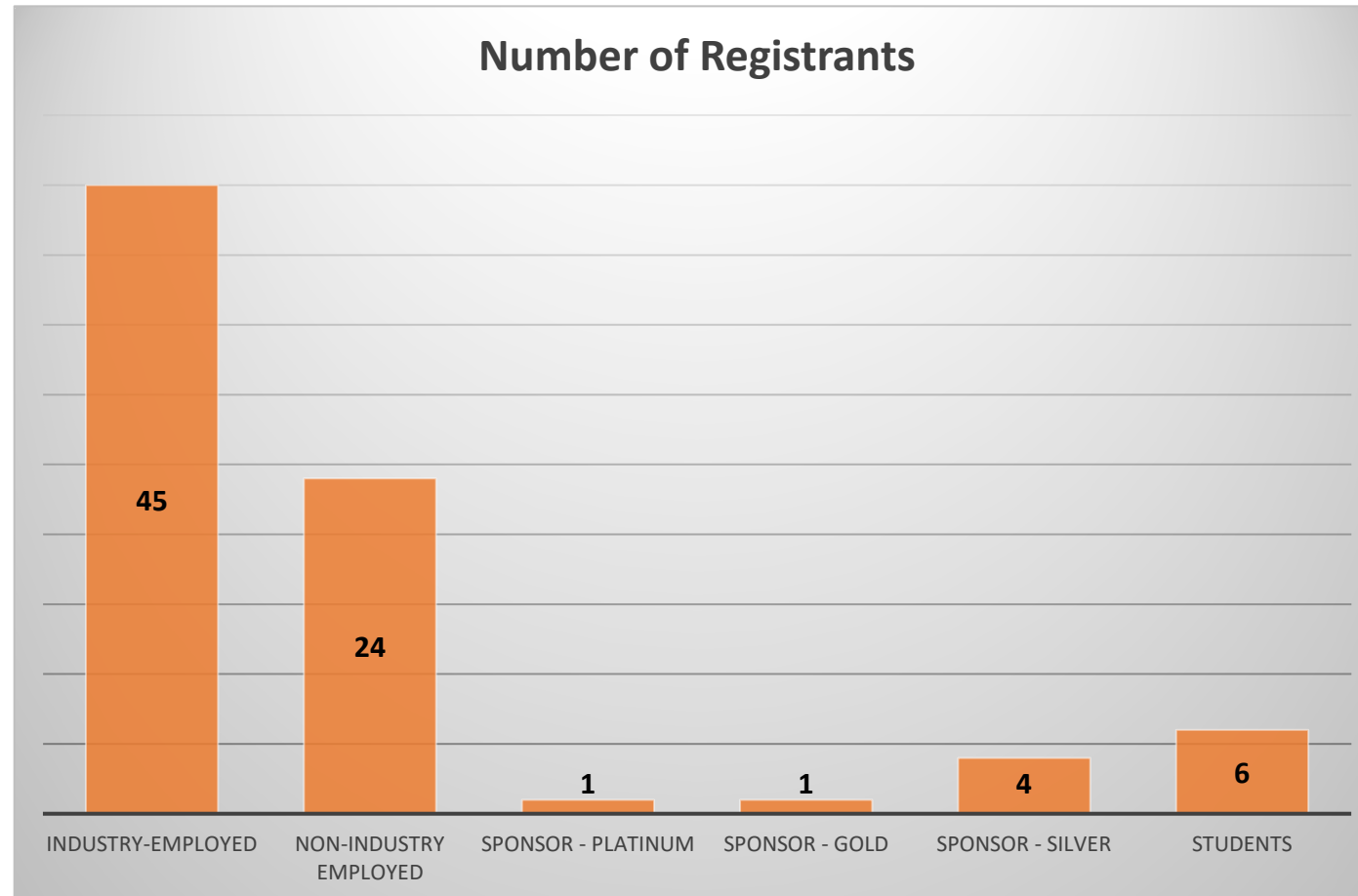

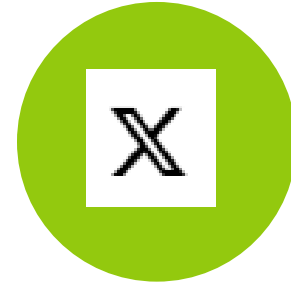
