## Key Responsibilities

### 1. Support Student Chapter Leadership

- Provide strategic oversight and mentorship to drive chapter growth, sustainability, and recognition (e.g., Chapter of the Year Award)
- Support funding needs, P&T Competition coordination, and key chapter initiatives

### 2. Collaborate with AMCP Leadership

- Partner with local and regional AMCP Diplomats, regional Affiliates (e.g., Student Affairs Chair), and the Schools of Pharmacy Relations Committee (SOPRC) to expand student opportunities and engagement

### 3. Advance Managed Care Education & Career Readiness

- Promote access to professional development and resources that prepare students for managed care pharmacy careers
- Advocate for integration of managed care content into the core curriculum and for academic credit tied to experiential activities (e.g., P&T Competition)
